PAFCOM GUIDELINES AND REQUIREMENTS

(For Participants to the 2006 PHILIPPINE AMERICAN FRIENDSHIP DAY PARADE)

I. Assembly / Registration:

- a) Assembly area - Jersey City Armory at the corner Montgomery Street and Jordan Street Jersey City, New Jersey.
- b) Mass - 8:00AM *(to be held at St. Aedan's, Bergen Road, JC, near the Assembly area)*
- c) Registration/ Assembly time - 8:00AM to 9:15AM *(Participants/marchers must register with the Command Post/ Registration Center located at the Assembly area in Montgomery Street in front of TopNotch Realty office.*
- d) Opening Ceremony - 10:00AM
- e) Start of Parade - 11:00AM

II. Parade Route:

- a) From the Jersey City Armory in Montgomery Street straight to - Exchange Place.
- b) Reviewing Grandstand located at the corner of Montgomery Avenue and Washington Street.
- c) Each group is allowed to perform no more than 60 seconds (1 minute) in front of the Reviewing Grandstand.
- d) Panel of judges are situated at the Reviewing Grandstand.
- e) Dispersal area is Washington Street (North & South).

III. Participants:

- a) Each group must have a banner to identify its organization.
- b) We encourage every group to provide a color motif for your costume, float or open car: Red, White, Blue or Yellow.
- c) All marchers must wear a common costume or uniform adopted by the organization.
- d) Costumes worn by marchers should conform to common standard of decency.
- e) All participants are encouraged to bring Philippine and US flags to wave along the parade route.

IV. Floats:

- a) The design and decor of floats must conform to the parade theme.

V. Open Cars (top down/convertible cars only) / Pickup Trucks:

- a) Limited to one (1) Open car or Pickup Truck per organization.
- b) Open car / Pickup Truck must be appropriately decorated.
